Gardens of the Fox Cities is available to rent for your wedding ceremony, reception, rehearsal dinner party, or anniversary.

To assure your special occasion is a success, Gardens of the Fox Cities has a rental agent to assist with scheduling and coordinating your special event.

Gardens of the Fox Cities is a 38 acre public garden and has been open as a horticultural and recreational resource to the Fox Valley region since 1992. The Gardens was developed around a native Wisconsin themed gardens which lends itself to beautiful photos.

Scheig Learning Center

A key feature at the Gardens is the Henry and Mary Scheig Learning Center which opened its doors to the public during the summer of 1996.

Charles Montooth, a protégé of Frank Lloyd Wright and senior architect with Taliesin Architects of Spring Green, Wisconsin, designed the building. This unique building boasts soaring timbers and skylights indicative of Wright's influence. The main level features a Great Room complete with a waterfall feature while the upper level of the Center



has a modest conference room for preparation for your event. Both levels of the building are handicap accessible.

The Scheig Learning Center can seat 100 people for a sit-down ceremony and sit-down dinner reception or 150 people for an hors d'oeuvres reception.



Selle Garden of Roses

A lovely garden venue for wedding ceremonies is the Selle Garden of Roses. This garden was designed in the theme of an English Rose Garden and features hybrid tea roses, climbing roses, shrub roses, floribunda roses and grandiflora roses. The ballerina sculpture was designed by Dallas Anderson.
